Individuals can rent a 10x10 space to sell no-longer-used treasures or showcase hand-made crafts.

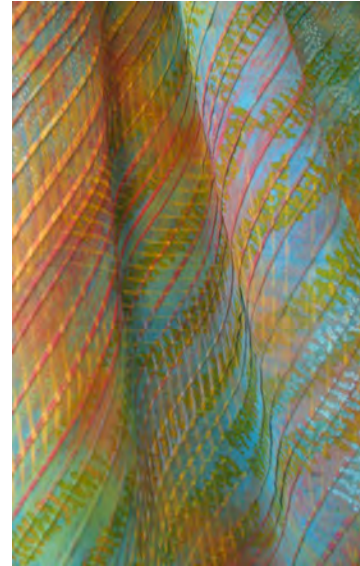
Set-up time will begin at 6:00 a.m., with the doors open to the public from 8:00 a.m.—4:00 p.m.

Our August First Friday will present the work of painter and mixed media artist Kathleen Isacson in the Sage Gallery and photographer Ilma Udrenas in the Dole Gallery.

Kathleen Sullivan Isacson has worked in a variety of media including oil, photography, paper arts, art installations and performance art. Currently, she has devoted much of her time to developing spiritual aspects of her work and working to utilize the arts as a way to in-

Photographer Ilma Udrenas shows her images in two different processes—cyanotype and digital. Cyanotype is a photographic printing process that gives a cyan-blue print and is a very old process. Cyanotype is the early childhood of photography. It was discovered in the century the Dole Mansion was built. The other images are printed in a digital photography process. The oldest and the newest processes in photography will meet here. Ilma describes her work this way, "I admire capturing fragile moments when past meets the present. You can "touch" the past at the Dole Mansion."

Make your plans early for these various culinary experiences and sign – up as soon as possible. You could miss out on a great class if you wait too long!

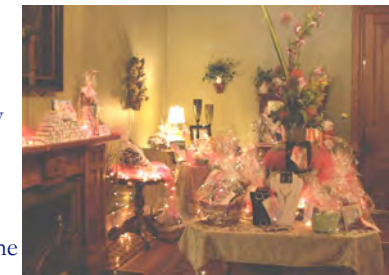


## Savvy Sister Soiree
